### Spring Feasts

Pesach ( Passover)

## 1st Parenthetical ISRAEL FEASTS

EX. 12:2 taking of the lamb

EX. 12:6,7 slaughtering of lamb and the blood  
on the door posts

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Ex. 12:13 God passes over the house w/blood

Ha Ha Matzvah (Feast of unleavend bread)

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EX. 16:15-20 Eating of Unleavend bread 7 days in haste

Bikkurim (Feats of First Fruits)

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Lev. 23:1,2; 9-14; Num. 18 First fruits offered  
to the Levi priests. These were the people to God offered to be set free from bondage

Shavout (Pentecost/feast of weeks (49))

EX. 23:14-19, Lev.23:15-16 and Deut.16:10.

Giving of the Law on Mt. Sinai

### Non-feast Parenthetical -Teshuvah

2 witnesses during Teshuvah

Dead to living witness

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1 st Witness = Moses - 2nd time on Mt. Sinai = 40 days  
without food and water = Ex. 34:28

Living witness

2nd witness = Elijah - He ran for forty days without food and water after leaving  
Mt. Carmel then to Beersheba, where Abram's 7 wells were & where God made an  
oath to Abram. The he was fed by an angel 1 Kings 19:3-9 and went to Mt. Sinai without  
food and water for 40 days (Referred to as 1st Elijah)

## **Fall Feasts**

**Rosh Hashanah/ Yom Terah (Feast of Trumpets)**

The preparation of meeting God in giving of the Law Ex. 19

**Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement)**

The giving of the Law Ex. 20

**Sukkot (Feast of Tabernacles)**

The feast of the building of the tabernacle in the wilderness Ex. 23,26,-30

## **2nd Parenthetical JESUS -CHRISTIAN CHURCH FEASTS**

Jesus offered as the passover lamb

1 Cor. 5:7; Jn. 1:49; Ex. 12:13; Mark 14:12; 1 Pet. 1:19; Rev. 13:8

Jesus was the unleavened bread - 1 Cor. 5:7;

Jesus became the feast of firstfruits of those who follow

Because of Jesus' death he brought the power of the Holy Spirit.  
Jn. 14-16

1st witness = Jesus- Was in the wilderness for 40 days after  
his baptism- Luke 4:1-13

2nd witness = John the Baptist, John 1:19 -28  
(Referred to as 2nd Elijah Mal. 4:5)

2nd witness = The Apostles, Acts 1:8

## **3rd Parenthetical TIME OF END (1844) FEASTS**

We receive the lamb in the outer court at the altar of burnt sacrifice

Lev. 1:4; 5:5, Numbers 5:7

The scapegoat ceremony Lev. 16:21

no sin/leaven in believers. Corresponds to the Scapegoat ceremony Lev. 16 (blotted out)

Those who live in Christ (Eph. 3:19; Col. 1:27) will be the firstfruits into the city

The Feast of Pentecost or Feast of Weeks. The Holy Spirit is placed on believers Acts 2:1-4

1st witness = Those sealed/died under the 3rd angel's message

2nd witness - Those 144k that live through the 7 last plagues

(Referred to as 3rd Elijah Mal. 4:5)

**In the wilderness preparatory to Yom Kippur of Isa. 61, Luke 4**

**Dan. 12:11,12 describes the 1290 and 1335. The time of 45 days describes Feast of Trumpets and Yom Kippur. The 45 days includes Teshuvah, F.O.T. and up to Yom Kippur. Days of cleansing for the 144k**

**Jesus came to the synagogue to preach the good news of Isa. 61, Luke 4**

**The 2nd coming of Jesus. Lev. 16 & G.C. p. 620,623. Sins blotted out**

**Jesus tabernacles with men Luke 4:14,15**

**7 days after Yom Kippur (2nd coming of Jesus) the feast of Tabernacles begins in heaven. Rev. 21:3 God tabernacles with man**
