50 days later from the day of first fruits Israel receives the Law at Mt. Sinai	<u>Sivan</u> 4th	<u>Sunday</u>	The early rain has ripened the wheat harvest and the wheat offering is presented before the threshold of the temple by the High Priest	Jesus spends 40 days with apostles on earth after resurrection. Jesus tells Apostles wait 10 days in upper room. 50th day the holy spirit poured as early rain.
